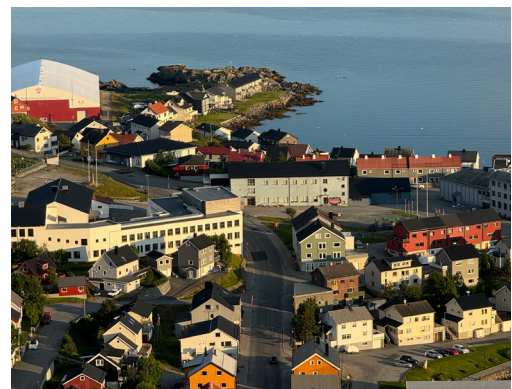

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About the North Cape

North Cape (Nordkapp in Norwegian) is located at the northern coast of the Magerøya island in Nordkapp municipality, and for centuries was regarded as the Northernmost point of continental Europe. Situated on a cliff, at approximately 300 meters above the sea level, the North Cape provides breathtaking views on the Barents sea, the midnight sun during the summer and Northern Lights during the winter months, as well as unforgettable feeling of reaching the end of the Continent. Next closest point to the North pole will be archipelago Svalbard.

Travelling to the North Cape is a monumental experience by itself. Being an important destination for expeditions in previous centuries and accessible only for explorers, who have been hiking the cliff from the sea, it is now available to everybody thanks to the completion of the road from Honningsvåg to the North Cape in 1956. With the modern road, and no need to hike the plateau, the journey to the North Cape is still as fascinating for today's travellers, as it was for explorers centuries before, with numerous possibilities of encountering local flora and fauna, as well as views of stunning landscapes. Nowadays, it is possible to reach the North Cape by car, bus, boat, bike, and by foot. The underwater tunnel from the mainland to Magerøya provides an excellent connection for those who like to take a road trip, and the airport in Honningsvåg is the main choice of those who like to travel by air. It is worth to mention, that since the North Cape is the farthest as well as the Northernmost point accessible by car, the weather plays central role at this location. If during the summer months the road is always open, on some winter days the road can be closed or be a subject to a convoy driving, which is an adventure of its own, but will require special preparation and assistance. Regardless of the season you are visiting this destination, and a choice of transportation, you will find all the necessary information about places to visit, things to see and do, driving conditions and necessary preparation for your trip to the North Cape in this manual. And do not worry about the weather! Nordkapp destination, while bathed in sunshine during the summer is as charming as when covered by a snow blanket in winter.

Welcome to the Nordkapp – to the end of the continent and the beginning of an adventure!

Travel information

Travelling is an exciting activity, which brings various emotions, whether it is a joy of moving from one place to the other, or the excitement of arriving to the particular destination. As Hans Christian Andersen put it: “To travel it to live”.

Despite the remote location, Nordkapp municipality has the year round accessibility with Honningsvåg as a transport hub, and everybody can find the way of transportation that suits him or her the best.

It is possible to reach Nordkapp by:

- Plane: [Honningsvåg airport \(HVG\)](#) has direct routes to [Hammerfest \(HFT\)](#) and [Tromsø \(TOS\)](#) airports.
- Boat: [Port of North Cape](#) welcomes numerous cruise ships from all around the world on continuous basis.
- Bus: [Snelandia](#) offers public bus transportation in Finnmark region.
- Car: road trip to the end of the Continental Europe is an exciting and memorable experience!

Good to know:

When planning a trip to the North Cape by car, it is important to keep in mind peculiarities of driving in the Arctic.

Firs and foremost it is crucial to follow all traffic rules and be a responsible and polite driver.

Secondly, even though travelling across the vast landscapes can be seen as an relaxing exercise, you must not lose attention on the road. Please remember about fellow road users, as well as about the the fact that there can be wild animals walking on the road.

If you feel tired, please park the car in the designated place, and have a rest.



Rules for convoy driving:

- Make sure you have enough fuel
- Keep flashlight, shovel and tow rope easy accessible
- It is wise to bring warm drinks and some food.
- Participants in the convoy must be equipped with winter clothes
- Avoid foggy windows by adjusting your ventilation system to supply cold air to your front windscreen
- Use emergency lights
- Use fog lights if your car is equipped with this.
- While driving in a convoy, never lose sight of the car in front of you.
- Keep a steady speed and follow the convoy
- Remain in the convoy at all times. Do not attempt to leave or turn away from the column.
- Stay in your vehicle even if you have to stop or the convoy comes to a halt.

Behind the convoy there is always another snow plow or safety vehicle. The driver in front and rear vehicles keeps contact during the convoy and the car in front may occasionally halt. Remember to follow the car in front of you, and in case of a traffical stop, to never leave your car.

Winter driving

Because of its far North location and the exposure to the Barents sea, Magerøya island in winter can often be at a mercy of the weather. Snow storms and strong winds are not an exception here, and thus winter journey by car requires special preparation. The road to the North Cape can be closed or a subject to convoy driving.

But do not let the weather discourage you. Arctic scenery in winter is breathtaking, and winter driving to the North Cape is an adventure on its own!

Magerøya island

Magerøya island is a home for Nordkapp municipality, with approximately 3300 inhabitants. About 2300 people live in Honningsvåg, the biggest town and an administrative center of the Nordkapp municipality; while the rest of the population is situated in four fishing villages: Gjesvær, Skarsvåg, Kamøyvær and Nordvågen.

The island is connected to the mainland by underwater tunnel (Nordkapptunnelen). The tunnel was opened for the passing traffic in 1999, it has the length of approximately 6.5 kilometers, and is buildt at a depth of more than 200 meters below the sea level.

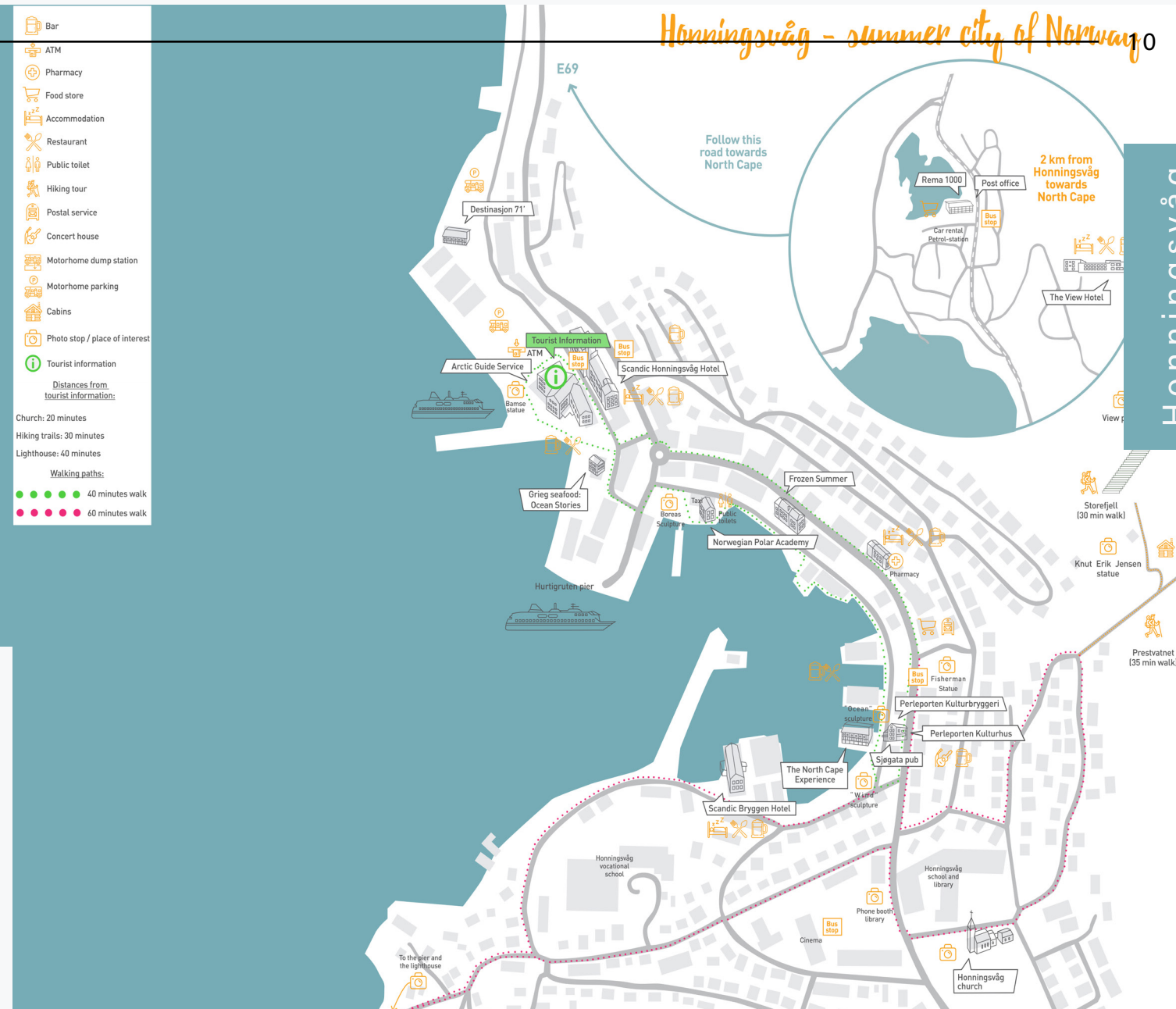
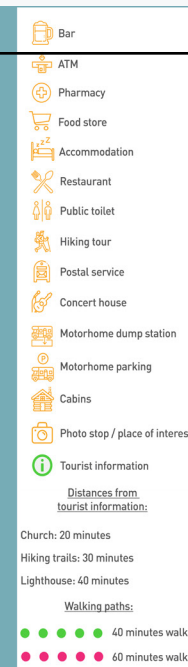
Geographically, Magerøya is located far above Arctic Circle, thus special weather conditions apply.

The period of polar day, when the sun never sets above the horizon lasts from the middle of May until the end of July; while the time of polar night, when the sun never rises above the horizon, accounts to the period from the end of November until the end of January.

When it comes to the temperatures, featuring subarctic climate, the island must be affected by long and very cold winters as well as very short and cold summers. But it is not entirely right. While it is true that winters are long and summers are relatively short, temperatures here, because of the Gulfstream current, are not so extreme. The average summer temperature on Magerøya island is around +12°C (53°F); while during the winter it is as warm as -2°C (28°F). The average highest temperature reaches +16°C (60°F) in August, and the average coldest is as low as -4°C (24°F) in February.

Because of the far north location, Magerøya island is a good place to experience Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis).

To be able to see this phenomenon, two conditions must apply: it must be dark and clear weather. Usually, the Northern Lights season lasts from September until March.



Honningsvåg

Honningsvåg is located on the southern coast of Magerøya island. It is a modern town which provides possibilities for shopping and various cultural and nature-based activities, as well as accomodation and sights of interest. Public services such as schools, library, museum, medical care, and law enforcement can be found in the city center. The port of the North Cape is also located in the very heart of the city.

Honningsvåg is often referred as a “Get-away” or a “Final stop” before reaching the Northernmost Point of the Continental Europe.

It has received the status of the city in 1996.

Since 2006 Honningsvåg boasts a tittle of [“Summer city of Norway” \(Norges sommerby\)](#) thanks to the victory in the competition held by NRK Travel Radio amongst the cities in Norway.

During the summer months Honningsvåg is a busy tourist city, welcoming cruise ships from all around the Globe. For instance, in 2024 Porth of North Cape welcomed 174 cruise ships, with the biggest of them bringing around 4 500 visitors.

Usually, the summer season begins from the middle of May, and lasts until the end of August.

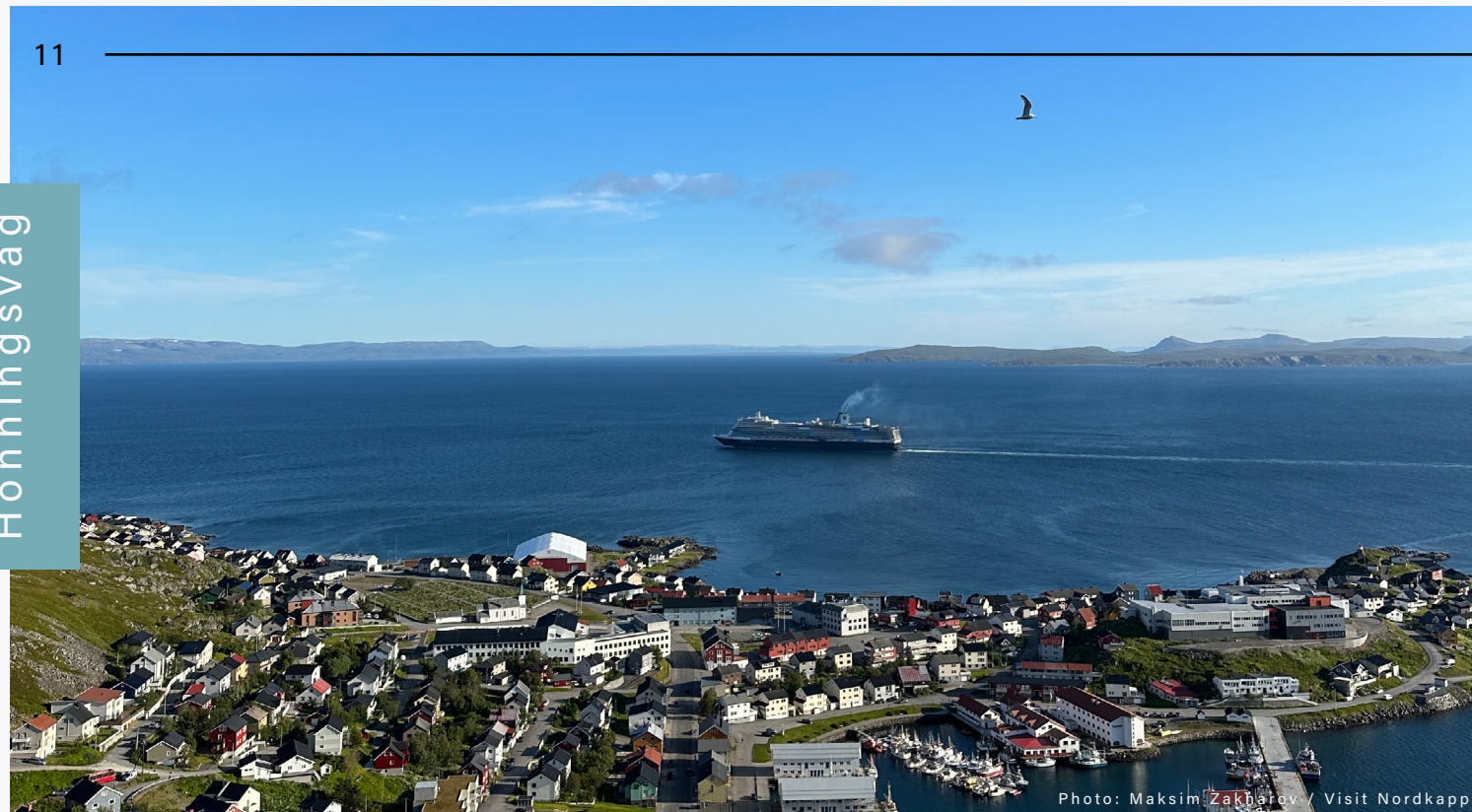

Last days of summer are celebrated by various festivals and cultural arrangements. Two of the biggest ones are Music Festival Oggasjakka, that takes place in Honningsvåg, and Bryggefestival in Skarsvåg.

Autumn dresses Honningsvåg and Magerøya into new colors. Hills and mountain peaks are radiating with hundreds shades of red and yellow, with the pinch of white fresh snow on summits.

And the sunsets are just breathtaking!

Winter brings calmness of the night, when the pace of life slows down, and nature takes full control of the city and the island. The beginning and the end of the winter is characterized by remarkably colorful clouds, while the middle of the winter is marked by the "Blue hour" - rare phenomena when due to the dissemination of light, everything around, even air, takes on a blue tint.

Nordvågen

Nordvågen is a dreamy fishing village, located in close proximity to Honningsvåg. With the population of about 400 people, it is the biggest fishing village on Magerøya island. Nordvågen is famous for having Norway's northernmost ski resort. In the summer time, Nordvågen is a starting point of the hiking trails to Helnes Lighthouse and Kjelvik.

Helnes Lighthouse is one of Europe's northernmost lighthouses. It was established in 1908, rebuilt around 1948, and automated in 2004.

Kjelvik is now an abandoned fishing village. The original name of Nordkapp municipality was Kjelvik, because initially it was the biggest settlement on the island.

Kamøyvær

Kamøyvær is the next in distance from Honningsvåg fishing village on Magerøya island. Located at about 10 kilometers towards the North Cape, and with the population of no more than 100 people, this charming place offers breathtaking views on the Risfjorden and Kamøyvær inner harbour.

This fishing village is protected from the open sea by two islands: Lille Kamøya and Store Kamøya. A small bird mountain is located near Store Kamøya.

Local art gallery, hiking trails, and view points along the road, are the most popular reasons to visit Kamøyvær.

Skarsvåg

Skarsvåg is a small fishing village, with the population of just about 60 people. It assumes the distinction of being the world's northernmost fishing village, and the distance from Skarsvåg to the North Cape is only 14 kilometers.

Apart from being the world's northernmost fishing village, Skarsvåg is famous due to Kirkeporten (The Church Gate) - a unique mountain formation. There is a hiking trail to Kirkeporten from Skarsvåg, which takes approximately 2 hours for a round trip. It is possible to see the horn of the North Cape from this trail, and on the summer nights the sun is shining right through the Church Gate.

Gjesvær

Gjesvær is the last on our list fishing village and a true pearl of Magerøya. With the current population of around 100 people, it is recognized as the only place in Finnmark known from the Viking Age. What makes this fishing village so unique is the Gjesværstappan - the group of steep mountains rising from the sea, creating islands: "Storstappen", "Kjerkestappen", and "Bukkstappen".

Those islands are a home for a large colony of seabirds (in total more than 60 000 pairs), and from 1983 they are designated area of nature reserve.

Due to the nesting of birds, it is prohibited to set foot on those islands from June 15 until August 15.

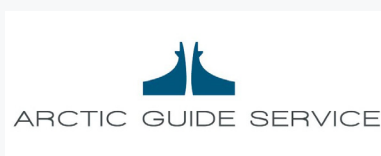

The snowy and dark surroundings of the winter season are simply breathtaking and there is a good chance to see the northern lights, dancing in all its nuances in the sky.

Bird Reserve of Gjesværestappan

This tour is a sure hit for bird watchers and is strongly geared towards nature.

Situated North West of the island of Magerøya, the bird reserve of Gjesvæstappan is home to the 2nd largest puffin colony in Norway. From May to August, razorbills, gannets, kittiwakes, cormorants and guillemots lead a busy life; they nest, dive, fish, breed and give life to a new generation.

White-tailed sea eagles are usually visible too.

This tour starts in Honningsvåg where you will meet the guide and the driver who will take you across the island to the old settlement of Gjesvær. There, you will get onto a repurposed fishing vessel that will sail very close to various bird cliffs, surrounded by swarms of birds.

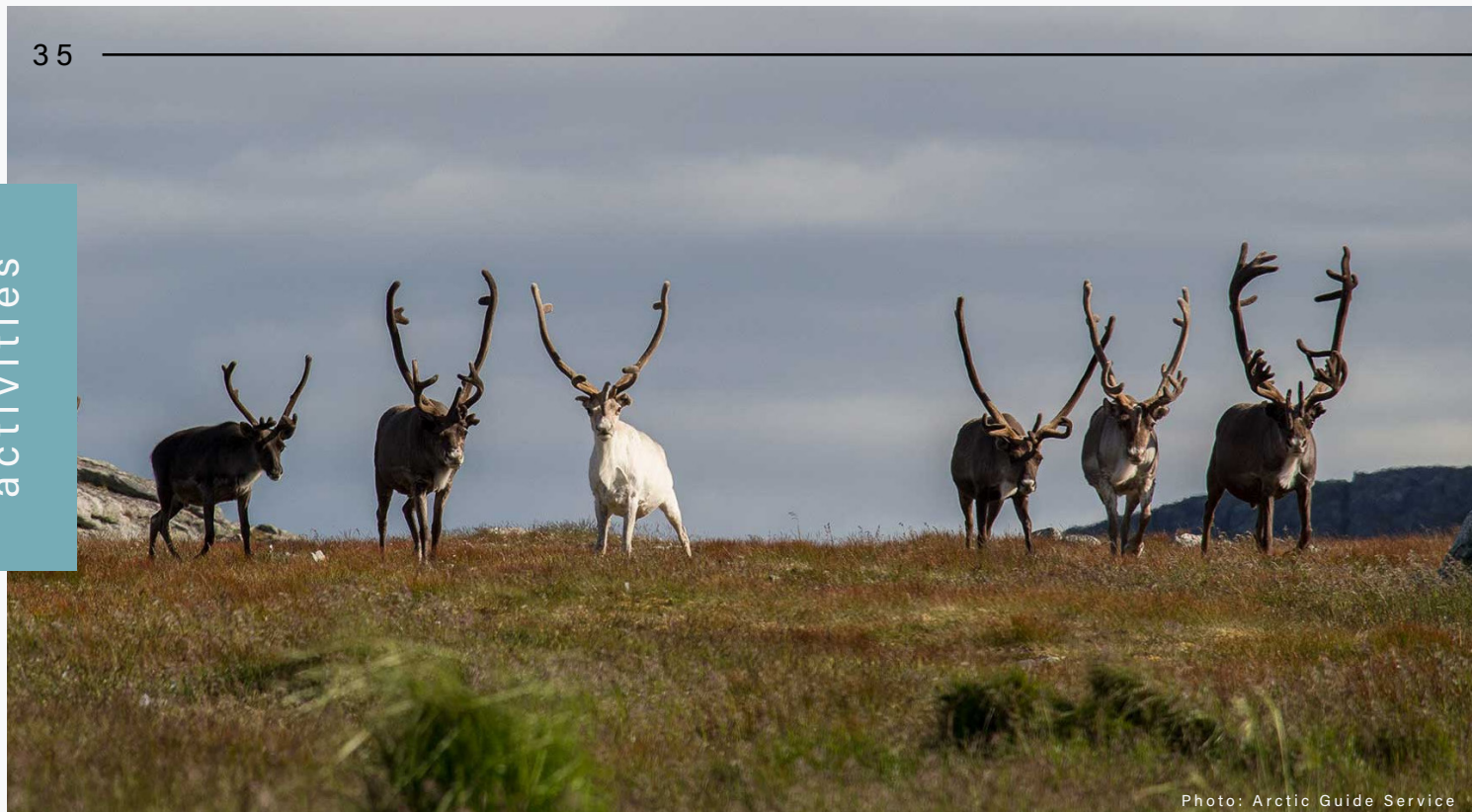

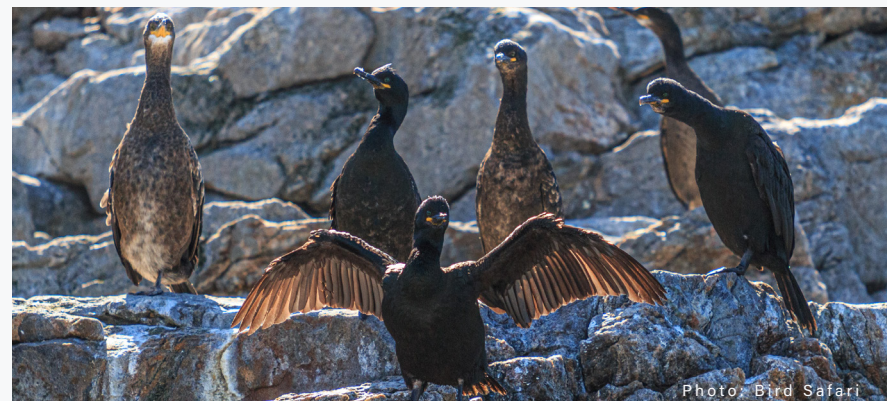

Bird Safari

This is one of your once-in-a-lifetime nature opportunities. The 1.5 hours boat tour leaves from Gjesvær to Gjesværstappan Nature Reserve, 15 km west of the Nordkapp cliff. You will be at the Gjesværstappan 10 minutes after departure from the pier. On the way you may get into one of our arctic suits to insure a warm bird safari. You can move freely onboard. We will address any question you might have. Even the captain is at your disposal. To set foot on the islands is not allowed, but from the boat you can observe one of Norway's largest groups of puffins and gannets. The puffins, easily recognisable by their colourful bill, nest in holes in the grassy hills. The nesting period, from April to September, teems with life in the air and on land. Mighty White-tailed Eagles can be seen hovering overhead as they hunt for prey.

A cup of coffee, biscuits and souvenirs can be purchased at the souvenir shop.
